

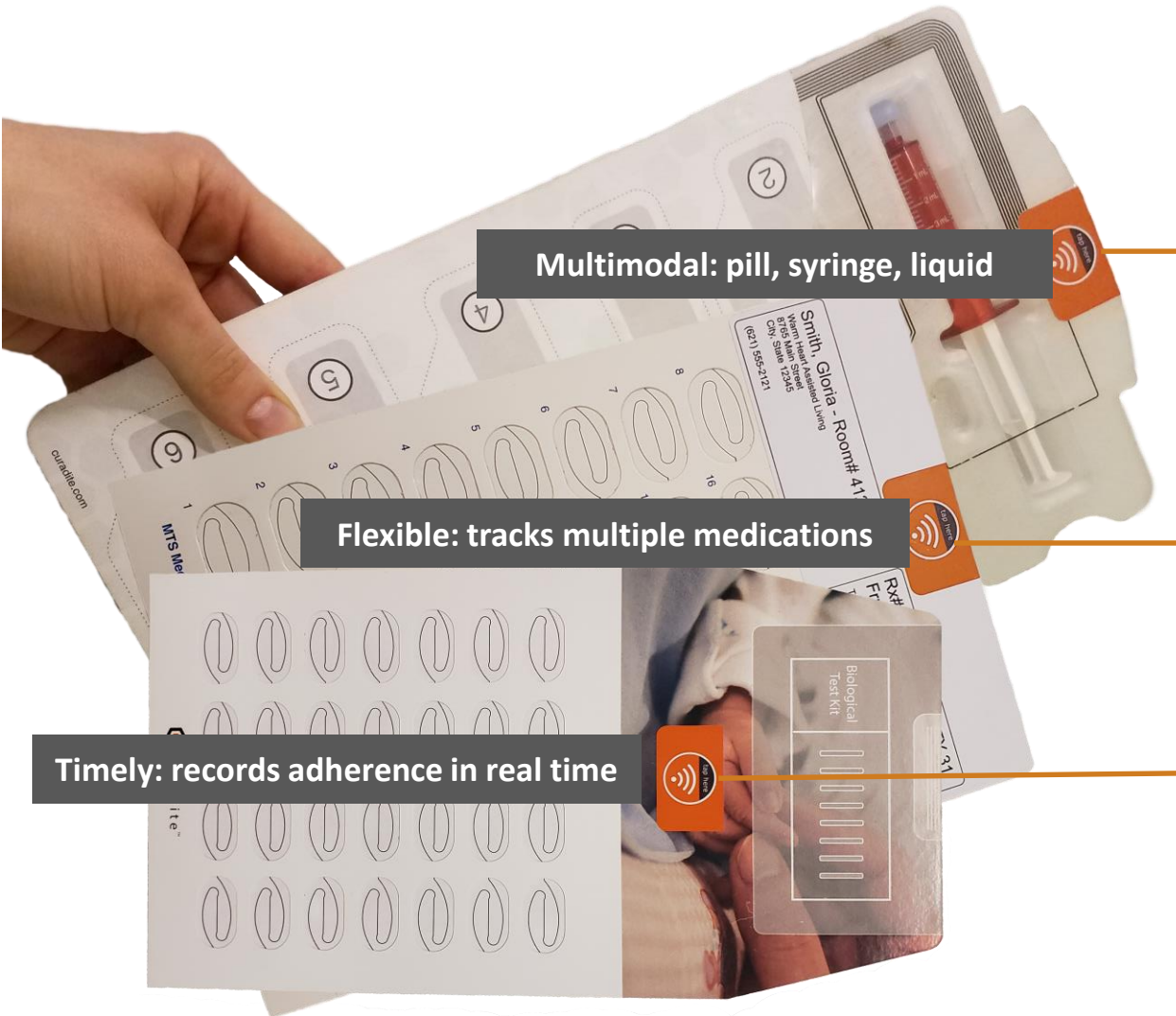

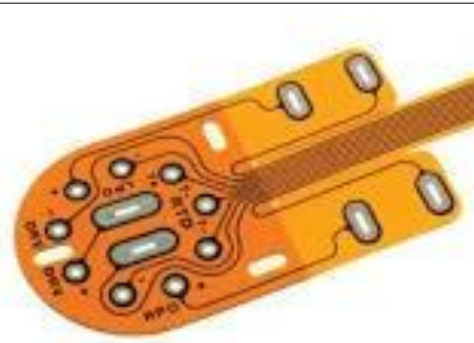

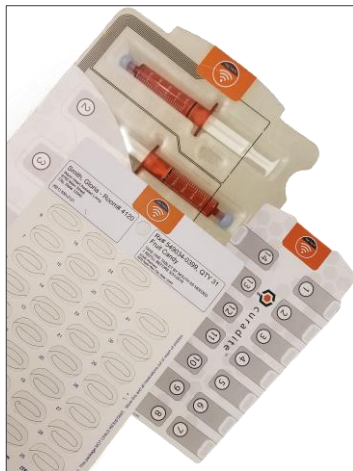

Curadite's medication management platform improves patient adherence, caregiver support and clinical data for a healthier world.

- Modular, intelligent packaging tracks medication events with real time support.
- Cloud-based dashboard monitors and records adherence for clinicians.
- A patient's parents, family members and/or friends can be part of their adherence support team.
- Timely reminders and alerts support adherence.
- HIPAA compliant, FCC certified.

Key Achievements

- 2019 National Epilepsy Foundation Awardee
- IP: Notification of utility patent received from USPTO. Provisional patent filed and trademarks approved
- \$100,000 Business Oregon Innovation Grant
- Completed first usability pilot with a regional long term care partner

Lessons Learned

- *Economic:* Medication non-adherence resulted in \$637 billion (U.S. dollars) in lost revenue for pharmaceutical manufacturers worldwide (2015).
- *Clinical:* Patients with epilepsy face higher expectations (95%+ adherence) and greater challenges (i.e. memory loss, ADHD); physicians and researchers remain reliant on patient reported adherence.
- *Technology:* Medication adherence success requires more than a smart phone app or digital pill.
- *Impact:* Medication adherence reduces SUDEP risk and ER events.
